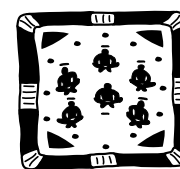
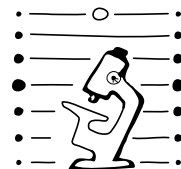
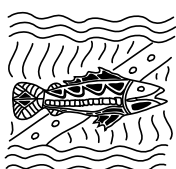
Over the last four years, the Northern Australia Hub of the Australian Government's National Environmental Research Program has undertaken research projects across Northern Australia's tropical savannas region that are relevant to Indigenous land and sea managers. The Hub would like to share the outcomes of this research with groups from the tropical savannas region of Cape York at a one day forum in Cairns. The Hub will also be interested in feedback from participants about how Indigenous land and sea management groups within Cape York would like future research programs to work with Indigenous groups and Traditional Owners. The event is being run in partnership with Balkanu Cape York Development Corporation.

**Getting there**

The Hub is able to cover travel and accommodation (for up to 2 nights) for 1 delegate from each Ranger group. In line with all other hub events, the Hub is not offering Travel Allowance to participants. We envisage travel to Cairns on Tuesday, 18th August with return travel on 20th August 2015. Additional participants from each group may attend but will not have travel or accommodation provided by the Hub.
